Seat for Forklift - A seat is a strong, strong surface to sit down, typically raised above floor level. Usually utilized by a single individual, nearly all seats are supported by four legs, even though some may be in a triangular shape using just three legs. A stool is a seat which does not have any arm rests or a back rest. A kind of seat that has folding action and an inclining footrest is called a recliner, while a seat along with arms only is considered an arm seat. If a seat has connected wheels, it could be known as a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is known as a swing. A permanently attached seat in a train or a theatre is called a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type found within cars and an infant car seat will be a seat specifically designed for young children.

The design of the seat could vary somewhat considerably so as to accommodate several requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an example, designs could be decorated with drilled holes, could include gaps or low backs for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back may be designed as an included headrest by extending the height over the occupant's head. Seats can be constructed along with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is intended to be utilized as a movable footrest. From time to time the ottoman can be attached to a glider chair with swing arms, permitting the ottoman to rock back and forth along with the glider like a rocking chair along with a built-in footrest.

Seat covers are temporary fabric covers meant for a seat which can provide protection against wear and add beauty. A large range of seat covers from leather to neoprene are presently on the market. More formal materials could be rented for occasions such as weddings to increase the decor. Some seat covers have decorative seat ties or bows connected to be tied at the back of the seat in a ribbon or decorative knot. Various people make use of customized clear plastic furniture covers to be able to protect their costly sofas and seats.

Seat pads provide cushioning for hard seats, even though several are usually decorative. Several could even be used in order to add to a driver's height within motor vehicles.
