Total sales for that year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various parts. Within 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is among the leading worldwide makers within the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively engage in new business opportunities. All through the final 60 years, the industry of material handling has developed into a really advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade currently continues to grow as the premier supplier of lift truck accessories and different associated products. The business feels assured in their skill in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, manufacturing and promoting hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was completed in the year 1956 on a brand new office so as to accommodate all of the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present headquarters. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

The next manufacturing plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Palmdale. 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the international world of the material handling industry while the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In 1964, the business altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in the year 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing amenities within the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Palmdale and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are fabricated globally due to numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 after buying five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide best in forks.
